Notes on the master's thesis in English natural science programs:

¹ Only students who have completed at least 75 ECTS credits will be admitted to the Master's thesis.

For **Food Systems**, students who have completed at least 60 ECTS will be admitted to the Master's thesis.

² The Master's thesis must be written in English.

³ The Master's thesis may be supervised by persons authorized to conduct examinations. These are

- Professors,
- university lecturers or private lecturers,
- junior professors and
- academic staff members with examination authorization.

For **Food Science and Engineering** one supervisor must full-time employee in one of the following departments: Dept. of Process Engineering and Food Powders (150c), Dept. of Plant-Based Foods (150d), Dept. of Dairy Science and Dairy Technology (150e), Dept. of Food Materials Science (150e), Dept. of Food Materials Science (150g), Dept. of Process Analysis and Grain Science (150i), Dept. of Yeast Genetics and Fermentation Technology (150f), Dept. of Food Microbiology and Hygiene (150a), Dept. of Bioprocess Engineering (150k), Dept. of Flavor Chemistry (150h), Dept. of Food Informatics (150l)

For **Food Biotechnology** one supervisor must full-time employee in one of the following departments:

Dept. of Food Microbiology and Hygiene (150a), Dept. of Biotechnology and Enzyme Science (150b), Dept. of Yeast Genetics and Fermentation Technology (150f), Dept. of Bioorganic Chemistry (130b), Dept. of Bioprocess Engineering (150k), Dept. of Food Chemistry and Analytical Chemistry (170a)

For **Earth and Climate System Science** one supervisor must be from the University of Hohenheim.

⁴ In general, the Master's thesis is to be written at an institution of the University of Hohenheim. In exceptional cases, the Master's thesis can be written at an institution outside the University of Hohenheim where the framework conditions for university research work are ensured. Such an external Master's thesis must be applied for and approved by the examination board with the following information before the work begins:

- Working title of the Master's thesis
- Exposé of the Master's thesis
- Reasons why the Master's thesis is to be written externally,
- Name of the supervising person according to the external person. This person must also be authorized to examine (see above), Name of the second examining person (examiner from the Faculty of Natural Sciences; exception ECSS: University of Hohenheim).

⁵ The master's thesis must be submitted digitally by 02:00 p.m. on the day of submission. If the submission in paper form is requested here, two copies of the thesis must be submitted to the examination office by 11:59 p.m. on the day of submission.

⁶ The deadline for the preparation begins with the assignment of the topic. This is usually the date on which the examiner signs the application form.
