



Information sheet | Request for recognition of coursework and examinations for admission into a degree program in a higher subject-related semester

Degree programs in the Faculty of Natural Sciences

Submit the following documents:

1. Complete request form
2. Detailed description of the competences, e.g. excerpt from the module catalog or a detailed lecture outline.
 - It must be absolutely clear and without doubt which year and which coursework / examination the documents included are for.
 - Complete module catalogs cannot be accepted.

Please sort the module descriptions in the order of the entries in the overview table of your completed coursework/examinations (see page 2 of the request form). The documents must be uploaded all in one PDF document.

3. Original transcript of records with information on individual grade (to be verified online or confirmed by an authorized office at the issuing university).

General information:

All requirements for recognition must be able to be seen in the request and documentation without any further research.

Admission is only possible if the student still has a right of admission to an examination in the degree program for which they are applying.

Admission is usually only possible if coursework and examinations totaling at least one semester's worth of work is recognized.

For degree programs with a restricted number of places, a place must be available.

In the application process, only those coursework and examinations can be recognized for which proof has been submitted by the application deadline.

Recognition of additional coursework and examinations may be requested at the Examinations Office within three months after the start of the semester for which admission is granted. If the request is not received by the Examinations Office together with the required documents by the deadline, the right to recognition is lost.

Important: The module name in the transcript of records and in the module catalog must be the same! It must be absolutely clear which module content and ECTS points have been assigned which grade. If the documents are incomplete or unclear, a review is not possible. In that case, recognition cannot be granted.
