who are at the beginning of their postgraduate studies. The scholarship is offered for two years. Start of scholarship is May 2023, payment is expected to be made (retroactively) from August 2023. An extension may be granted only in exceptional and well-justified cases for a maximum of 12 months. The formal conditions of acceptance as a doctoral candidate at the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences of the University of Hohenheim have to be fulfilled by the applicant.
