Program Purpose

Teaching Purpose

University teachers have the opportunity to teach at the University of Hohenheim. This is possible in any department. The required teaching load is eight hours for the first week of stay, for further days of stay the minimum number of hours is calculated proportionally.

General Information

The Erasmus+ program aims to promote exchange and academic cooperation with countries worldwide. The University of Hohenheim was awarded an Erasmus+ grant to cover individual grants for Staff- and/or Student Mobilities between the University of Hohenheim and institutions in the Partner Country South Africa.

Prerequisite:

An Inter-Institutional Agreement (IIA) must be concluded between the University of Hohenheim and your institution in South Africa.

Target Group:

Academic or non-academic staff of partner institutions of the University of Hohenheim in South Africa.

Eligibility period:

Stays must be completed before July 31, 2023.

Benefits

Financial support for stays at the University of Hohenheim from a minimum of **5 to a maximum of 60 days** under the Erasmus+ program with partner countries.

The amount of support is staggered as follows:

Amount up to and including 14th funding day of the stay: **160 EUR/day**

Amount from 15th funding day of the stay: **112 EUR/day**

Travel Allowance

In addition, participants will receive a grant for travel allowance based on one-way distance (determined by the EU Commission calculator).

Single distance according to distance calculator	Amount per participant (= round trip)
10-99 km	20 EUR
100-499 km	180 EUR
500-1.999 km	275 EUR
2.000- 2.999 km	360 EUR
3.000 3.999 km	530 EUR
4.000 7.999 km	820 EUR
8.000 km or more	1,500 EUR
