Call for Collaborative Research Proposals 2022/23

The joint research program of the University of Hohenheim and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem was initiated in 1987, with the purpose of promoting a high scientific standard of collaboration. Both Universities are seeking to use this partnership to promote substantial and high impact research.

Objectives of collaboration:

- To promote excellence by supporting challenging and innovative collaborative research carried out at the FANUHOH and the FAHUJI.
- To sponsor research, including exchange of young M.Sc. or Ph.D. students.
- To provide seed money, to facilitate and promote future research projects by other funding bodies (e.g., DFG, EU, GIF, DIP), initiated by early career scientists. Grantees are expected to submit a proposal to external funding sources, at the conclusion of this funding program.

Proposal submission deadline:

- Submission deadline for proposals is November 15th, 2021. Please send your proposal as one pdf file to:

Eligibility:

- Submissions are open to all FAHUJI (tenure-track) and FANUHOH scientists, holding at least a Ph.D. degree. Participation of early career scientists is strongly encouraged.
- Criteria outlined below with the restriction of one "rest" cycle from the year following a successful submission.
- Each investigator may only submit one joint application. One partner on each side is preferred.

Level of funding and project duration:

- Funding for a collaborative research project is limited to a period of two years, starting in early 2022.
- The budget for each 2-year-project is approximately 50,000 € per side for each project.
- Parallel submissions to other funding sources are highly encouraged.

Online matchmaking event:

In order to assist in the partner search, we have scheduled a one-day **joint webinar on May 19**th, **2021** at 1pm (Hohenheim)/ 2pm (Israel).

The program including opening words, introductory lightning rounds and breakout rooms will be sent closer to date.

Workshop in Israel:

- The next bi-annual workshop of our joint research program will be at the Hebrew University on November 1st 2nd, 2021, pending COVID developments.
- Applicants are expected to present their projects during the workshop, either in person or via Zoom (pending COVID restrictions).

Application structure:

- Please submit a single proposal, in which the roles of each partner are clearly defined.
 The proposals (max. 14 pages) should include the following:
 - Project title, names and affiliations of submitting scientists and full contact details
 - Abstract (maximum one page)
 - Body of proposal (maximum five pages) including:
 - o Background and rationale
 - Objectives and hypotheses
 - o Materials, methods and experimental approach
 - Expected results and outcomes
 - Collaboration (with a clear indication of exchange of postgraduates)
 - Prospect: potential joint projects for future submissions to external funding agencies. Anticipated grant agencies and approximate call dates should be added.
 - References (not counted in page limit)
 - Appendixes:
 - a. Short CV of each partner, inc. academic background, current position and a list of relevant publications from the past 5 years.
 - b. Details of prior submissions to the joint research program, if applicable.
 - c. List of submissions to external German-Israeli funding sources, with previous partners from this funding scheme (including year of submission, source and funding status).
 - One page report on previous projects funded by the joint research program, if applicable.
 - o Budget: Results of funded collaborations will be presented at the joint bi-annual workshop. Both partners are requested to earmark at least 500 € within the budget (1,000 € per project) to cover expenses for participation in the workshop. Please justify the budget for each item and present the budget in a yearly format.

Evaluation of proposals

Collaborators who apply after a "rest" period, will need to detail joint submissions to funding agencies that were submitted (and which ones were granted) following previous grant. A commission, consisting of members of the faculties involved will evaluate the proposals, based on the following criteria:

- Scientific innovation, quality and potential.
- Clear description of project proposals to be submitted to an external funding body, during and upon completion of the project.
- Collaboration and exchange of young M.Sc. and Ph.D. students between FAHUJI and FANUHOH.
- Priority will be given to early career scientists.
