Dear Partner,

The Erasmus+ program aims to promote exchange and academic cooperation with countries worldwide. The University of Hohenheim was awarded an Erasmus+ grant to cover individual grants for Staff- and/or Student Mobilities between the University of Hohenheim and institutions in the Partner Country South Africa.

Come to the University of Hohenheim for teaching or training!

Target Group: Academic or non-academic staff of partner institutions of the University of Hohenheim in South Africa.

Program Purpose:

Mobility for teaching purposes: University teachers have the opportunity to teach at the University of Hohenheim. This is possible in any department. The required teaching load is eight hours for the first week of stay, for further days of stay the minimum number of hours is calculated proportionally.

Possible activities:

- Participation in examinations
- Professional supervision/supervision of students
- Joint events and seminars
- Courses/lectures

Mobility for training purposes: Staff of partner institutions of the University of Hohenheim in South Africa can be supported in their professional development through professional development measures.

Possible activities:

- Joint events and seminars
- Job shadowing/hospitation
- Participation in a Staff Training Week
- Tutorials/Seminars/Workshops

Benefits: Financial support for stays at the University of Hohenheim from a **minimum of 5 to a maximum of 60 days** under the Erasmus+ program with partner countries. The amount of support is staggered as follows:

Amount up to and including 14th funding day of the stay: 160€ per day

Amount from 15th funding day of the stay: 112€ per day

In addition, participants will receive a grant for travel expenses based on one-way distance (determined by the EU Commission calculator).

Eligibility period: Stays must be completed before **July 31, 2023**.

Prerequisite: An Inter-Institutional Agreement (IIA) must be concluded between the University of Hohenheim and your institution in South Africa.
